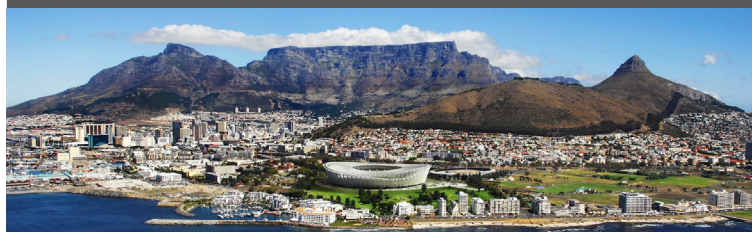

On through Chapmans Peak, one of the world's most breathtaking coastal drives to Cape Point and the Good Hope Nature Reserve, which has magnificent fynbos vegetation, birdlife, endemic antelope species and zebra, historic lighthouses and shipwrecks. Cape Point is perceived to be the meeting point of the Atlantic and Indian Oceans.

GOLF DAY - DE ZALZE (B)

De Zalze offers a fine mix of parkland holes, its main defenses being the water features on several of the holes. The oak-lined Blaauwklippen river winds its way through the golf estate and comes into play at various intervals. The club has been quick to reap rewards since its opening in 2000. De Zalze was selected to host the 2006 World Amateur Team Championships, is ranked 24th in the latest Golf Digest Top 100 Courses and De Zalze also received a service-orientated "Five-Star Golf Experience" Award, managed by Complete Golfer, joining only 14 other courses out of over 450 courses in South Africa to achieve this honor. The course is not easy. Water, huge fairway- and deep green-bunkers make it difficult for the player. Spectacular is the 3rd tee-off situated on an island..The evening is free.

HERMANUS (B)

After a lazy morning we make our way to Hermanus, Home of the best land based Whale viewing in the world. Not convinced... well you will be. Our hotel, the Windsor, is situated within touching distance of the crashing waves and will be our home for tonight. On the way we make a stop at Betty's Bay to visit the penguin colony.

GEORGE – FANCOURT (B,D)

On this morning we continue along the coast to George and our golf resort for the next few nights, Fancourt. We have dinner together here tonight.

GOLF DAY – OUTENIQUA (B,D)

Outeniqua, ranked in the top 20 courses in SA, is named after the mountain range that overlooks the area. The course is open in appearance, yet it has its share of challenges and risk-and-reward moments. Water hazards or streams come into play on as many as 11 of the holes, including 4 of the last 5. The warm-up area, featuring a full-length range and a chipping and bunker practice area, is available to all golfers before play. We have dinner again this evening at the hotel.

GOLF DAY – MONTAGU (B)

Today we play the second course here at Fancourt, the Montagu. Montagu, named after the Montagu pass was originally designed by Gary Player and is a much celebrated parkland course. The exquisitely conditioned Montagu is at the heart of Fancourt, with its glorious parkland layout, covering large tracts of varying terrain on rolling land. It's beauty is enhanced by mature trees, flower beds, shrubs and water hazards that provide a colorful contrast to the landscape.

KNYSNA (B)

Today we leave the Fancourt and transfer to Knysna. We will have time for you to explore the town before driving to our hotel at the Simola Golf Club. Located high up in the hills above Knysna (South Africa's favorite holiday town), Simola Golf & Country Estate is a world apart. From its vantage point, the 325-hectare Estate looks out a spectacular panorama encompassing the full expanse of the Knysna Lagoon, all the way to the Heads and beyond to the sea. The magnificence of the site inspired golfing legend Jack Nicklaus to design a masterpiece amidst the rolling hills of the Simola Estate.

GOLF DAY – SIMOLA (B,L,D)

We play the Simola course today. Fairways merge seamlessly with lush indigenous vegetation and forests creating an evocative vista of undulating green hills and dales descending gently down to the Knysna River. A Halfway House lunch is included.

TRANSFER DAY (B)

Today we drive back to George Airport, where we take the flight to Johannesburg. On arrival, we transfer to the Mondior hotel within the Emperors Palace, close to the airport.

KRUGER NATIONAL PARK (B,D)

This morning we make our way to the most famous park in South Africa. Teaming with wildlife, abundant vistas and scenic splendours, we will make a slow game drive to our accommodation, Berg en Dal Chalets. Berg en Dal Rest camp was opened in 1984, meaning 'mountain and dale' aptly named for its superb location. Great care has been taken to preserve the natural vegetation in the camp area, which comprises Malelane Mountain Bushveld (woodland), attracting a variety of grazers. The area hosts White Rhino, Kudu, Impala, Giraffe, some Elephant, Reedbuck, Klipspringer, Grey Rhebok and warthog. Leopard and Wild Dog are regularly seen in the region. Lion are usually found in the lower plains on the roads to Skukuza and Crocodile Bridge. Bird watchers will find the appeal of Berg en Dal Restcamp irresistible as a wide variety of birds species can be seen here. The chalets are set within natural bush and the gardens planted with flowering shrubs and aloes, leaving much of the natural habitat unchanged within the camp. Berg en Dal is one of the newest camps in the Kruger National Park and offers visitors outstanding accommodation and lodging facilities. Dinner tonight is at a Kruger Park restaurant.

After an early sunrise game drive in our own vehicle, you can relax by the pool for the rest of the day. Later, you have another opportunity to view the wildlife on a Sunset game drive in Parks vehicles.

We have our last round of golf today at the Royal Johannesburg & Kensington Golf Club which is one of the most prestigious golf clubs in South Africa. It has hosted 7 South African Opens and numerous other major tournaments. It is also home to the biggest annual professional golf event in Africa, the Joburg Open. We will have a farewell dinner together after the round at the golf club.

How to book

A deposit of \$2,000 per person is required together with a completed registration form to secure a reservation. The deposit becomes non-refundable after airfares have been booked. The final balance is due 60 days prior to departure and an invoice will be sent to you prior to this date. All prices are based on payment by cash, cheque, or direct credit. If you wish to pay by credit card, Charlie's Golf Tours accept Visa & MasterCard Payments made via credit card are subject to a 2% surcharge.

Taxes & other incidental costs

All airline & airport taxes are included in the tour price, as are tips for coach drivers, guides etc.

Flexibility

You may wish to consider departing earlier or extending your stay. As a fully bonded travel agency, we are able to assist you with flight itineraries, hotel bookings, car hire etc. If you choose not to take advantage of the flights quoted as part of the tour package, please be aware that you will be responsible for your travel to and from the tour start and finish points. Flights will be subject to availability and any applicable surcharges at the time of booking.

Travel insurance

Prices

All prices in the brochure are in New Zealand Dollars and are quoted per person. Due to possible currency fluctuations and changes in service costs, prices are subject to variation at any time up to departure.

Documentation

Travel Documents will be distributed approximately 20 days prior to departure date. Charlie's Golf Tours cannot accept responsibility for any documents or airline tickets which are subsequently altered without our consent or authorisation.

Visas / Passports

You will need a current passport with at least six months validity after the end of the tour date to travel overseas. A visa is required to travel to South Africa. We will send you details of how to apply for it after you have booked. It is necessary for you to attend an interview in either Auckland or Wellington at the start of the visa process. It is your responsibility to ensure you have the correct documentation allowing you to travel to the destinations on the tour.

Rooming arrangements

If you are travelling alone, but wish to share a room with someone else, please indicate this on your registration form. We will do everything possible to arrange quad/twin share accommodation in these instances. However if it cannot be arranged, the own room supplement will apply. Room definitions: Quad share = 2 bedroom/2 bathroom apartment; Triple share = three persons occupying a 2 bedroom apartment; Twin share = 1 bedroom apartment or hotel room (as indicated in the itinerary); Own room in 2 bedroom apartment = single occupancy of one bedroom in 2 bed apartment; Own room/apartment = single occupancy of a 1 bedroom apartment or hotel room.

Cancellations

Prior to flight ticketing refunds will be made in full.
After flight ticketing and before 60 days, refund of land only content.
60 – 30 days 50% of land only content
30 days – commencement of tour, no refund
We strongly recommend that you take out travel insurance at the time of booking in case of sickness or other problem that might prevent you travelling, as well as giving you peace of mind whilst you are on tour.

GENERAL TOUR INFORMATION

All standards of golf are catered for, but players should have an official NZGA handicap, or Australian equivalent.

Players are to provide their own golf clubs. It is most important that all golf gear (including shoes) must be thoroughly cleaned prior to leaving both New Zealand & Australia as it is highly likely that they will be inspected by both Australian and New Zealand Customs/Biosecurity. Dirty clubs or shoes may incur heavy penalties.

Motorised carts will be supplied where specified, with pull buggies provided at the rest (those players requiring motorised carts on all courses should indicate on the booking form). Upgrades from pull buggies to motorised carts will cost approx \$25 per player per round.

If you wish to book your own airfare, you will be charged for a land only price. If your flight times do not coincide with other travellers in the tour, you will be

required to make your own way to the accommodation at the start of the tour and to the airport at the end of the tour.

Payment for tours can be made by cheque, direct credit or credit card, however a 2% surcharge applies to all credit card transactions.

Accommodation is in 4 to 4.5 star rated accommodation – either bed and breakfast or fully self-contained apartments, handy to shops and services, as described in the tour itinerary.

This tour is contingent on sufficient numbers participating in the tour. If the tour does not go ahead due to lack of numbers, a full refund will be made.

Bookings are required at least 60 days prior to departure. Late bookings will be considered, but may be subject to a surcharge due to flight availability.
