GOLF DAY – THE HARVEST (B)

Pick up at 8.15 from the hotel and transfer to the Harvest golf course in Kelowna for a tee time of 9.00. The Harvest is a championship-length layout designed by renowned Canadian golf course architect Graham Cooke. Literally shaped from an orchard, many fruit trees still dot the course and add to its splendor. Evening Free

JASPER (B,D)

Today we check out of our hotel and take a full day sightseeing transfer to Jasper in the heart of the Rockies. The route follows the Thompson River through rolling plateaus to the snowy peaks of the Monashee Mountains. Time permitting we will stop at Wells Gray Provincial Park. Then onward to the expansive glaciers of the Albreda Icefields and keep the eyes open for grizzly, moose, beaver and osprey. Pass by Mt Robson, at 3,954 metres the highest peak of the Canadian Rockies. Then we cross into the province of Alberta and onto our classic Canadian lodge in Jasper, the Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge. This resort hotel is situated in the UNESCO world heritage site of the Jasper National Park. We will have a welcome dinner together tonight.

GOLF DAY – JASPER PARK (B)

Tee time 9.30 It took 50 teams of horses and 200 men working together for a year in order to clear the land of boulders and debris to prepare it for what would become one of Canada's premiere golf courses. Since the opening of the mountain golf course in 1925, this jewel set deep in the heart of the Canadian Rockies has been the setting of unforgettable memories for all of those who come to play. Stanley Thompson, Canada's master golf course architect, displayed some of the finest work of his career with this design. The layout offers elevated tee boxes, dramatic bunkering and holes aligned with distant mountain vistas. He built wide fairways that carve through thick forest, and maintained a partnership with the environment's natural contours, blending beautiful landscapes with challenging terrain. As a result, few golf courses in the world can match the rugged majesty of this national treasure.

Here we will take a Glacier Adventure tour, giving us the opportunity to walk on a glacier. Bring a warm sweater with you as it gets cold on the ice! We then stop again to enjoy Lake Louise with Victoria Glacier in its backdrop. We arrive in Banff late afternoon, where we will check into the Moose Hotel & Suites in the centre of Banff.

In 1989, a further 9 holes were added, resulting in 27 holes of championship Alberta golf yards depending on tee placement, it is a course that allows both scratch golfers and recreational players to enjoy the course and hone their skills. How to book

A deposit of \$2,500 per person is required (plus \$750pp if the cruise option is being taken) together with a completed registration form to secure a reservation. The deposit becomes non-refundable after airfares have been booked. A second deposit of \$2,000 is required 120 days prior to departure. The final balance is due 60 days prior to departure and an invoice will be sent to you prior to this date. All prices are based on payment by cash, cheque, or direct credit. If you wish to pay by credit card. Charlie's Golf Tours accept Visa, MasterCard Diners & American Express. Payments made via credit card are subject to a 2% surcharge.

Taxes & other incidental costs

All airline & airport taxes are included in the tour price, as are tips for coach drivers, guides etc. However, for those taking the cruise option, there is a charge of US\$12.00pp per day added to your on-board account for gratuities.

Flexibility

You may wish to consider departing earlier or extending your stay. As a fully bonded travel agency, we are able to assist you with flight itineraries, hotel bookings, car hire etc. If you choose not to take advantage of the flights quoted as part of the tour package, please be aware that you will be responsible for your travel to and from the tour start and finish points. Travel insurance

Prices

All prices in the brochure are in New Zealand Dollars and are quoted per person.

GENERAL TOUR INFORMATION

All standards of golf are catered for, but players should have an official NZGA handicap, or Australian equivalent.

Players are to provide their own golf clubs. It is most important that all golf gear (including shoes) must be thoroughly cleaned prior to leaving both New Zealand & Australia as it is highly likely that they will be inspected by both Australian and New Zealand Customs/Biosecurity. Dirty clubs or shoes may incur heavy penalties.

Motorised carts will be supplied where specified, with pull buggies provided at the rest (those players requiring motorised carts on all courses should indicate on the booking form). Upgrades from pull buggies to motorised carts will cost approx \$20 per player per round.

If you wish to book your own airfare, you will be charged for a land only price. If your flight times do not coincide with other travellers in the tour, you will be

Due to possible currency fluctuations and changes in service costs, prices are subject to variation at any time up to departure.

Documentation

Travel Documents will be distributed approximately 20 days prior to departure date. Charlie's Golf Tours cannot accept responsibility for any documents or airline tickets which are subsequently altered without our consent or authorisation.

Visas / Passports

You will need a current passport with at least six months validity after the end of the tour date to travel overseas. You will need to complete an online travel authorisation form (ESTA) prior to traveling, for Canada and the USA. All travellers to the USA and Canada are required to complete ESTAs before travel commences and if you take the 'add-on' cruise you must complete one as Alaska is part of the USA. It is your responsibility to ensure you have the correct documentation allowing you to travel to the destinations on the tour.

Rooming arrangements

If you are travelling alone, but wish to share a room with someone else, please indicate this on your registration form. We will do everything possible to arrange quad/twin share accommodation in these instances. However if it cannot be arranged, the own room supplement will apply. Room definitions: Quad share = 2 bedroom/2 bathroom apartment; Triple share = three persons occupying a 2 bedroom apartment; Twin share = 1 bedroom apartment or hotel room (as indicated in the itinerary); Own room in 2 bedroom apartment = single occupancy of one bedroom in 2 bed apartment; Own room/apartment = single occupancy of a 1 bedroom apartment or hotel room.

Cancellations

Prior to flight ticketing refunds will be made in full, after deduction of any tour deposits that have been made.

After flight ticketing and before 60 days, refund of land only content, less any deposits already made.

60 – 30 days 50% of land only content

30 days – commencement of tour, no refund
